Following up the e-mails I sent you on Monday, June 13th, about NY's *not-yet operational* and *publicly-inaccessible* Judicial Compensation Commission, Jennifer Golson of Thomson Reuters reported, on Thursday, June 16th, that "a coalition of more than 1,100 New York judges has asked the Commission for a 41-percent pay hike", which will cost taxpayers \$78 million, plus retroactive pay.

In the event you have not seen her June 16th article - and I have not found any reporting by you on either

the Judicial Compensation Commission or the pay raise issue since my June 13th e-mails – it is attached, for your convenience.

In response to this 1,100-plus judge coalition, I take the opportunity to announce that the Center for Judicial Accountability will be building a People's Taxpayer Coalition opposing ANY pay raise for the reasons set forth in our May 23rd letter to the Governor, Legislative Leaders, and Chief Judge, among others.
