Complaint Description	NYS Commission on Legislative, Judicial & Executive Compensation rendered a "false instrument" "force of law" November 14, 2024 Report to steal taxpayer money for statutorily-violative, fraudulent, and unconstitutional salary increases for Executive 169 state officers and possibly others – the appropriations for which, for FY2025-26, are unitemized and embedded throughout the State Operation Budget Bill #S.3000/A.3000.

- my complaint is true;
- any documents attached are true and accurate copies of the original; and
- I understand that this document may be filed in an action or proceeding in a court of law.
