Proposition One

- (1) Mark only with a writing instrument.
- (2) To vote for a candidate whose name is on the ballot, fill in the oval completely to the right of the candidate's name.
- (3) To vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, fill in the oval completely to the right of the candidate's name.
- (4) To vote yes or no on a proposal, if the proposal is on the ballot, fill in the oval completely for either YES or NO.
- (5) Any other mark or writing, or any other mark, will result in your ballot being rejected.
- (6) Do not overvote. If you select a proposition and a candidate, your ballot will be rejected.
