New Yorkers' busy schedules often make it difficult to get to the polls and vote. That's why NYS Senate Majority Leader Andrea Stewart-Cousins passed a law to allow registered voters to vote in person before Election Day – starting October 26 – at a designated early voting site.

Early voting works the same as voting on Election Day. Just show up at your early voting site, check in to receive your ballot, and cast your vote!

Your early voting location may be different from your Election Day polling site.
