Dear Mr. Flanagan,

1. My May 24th, 1994 letter to you which stated that the opinion in the above matter was mailed to me on May 2, 1994, was in error, it was mailed to me in response to my letter of, and after, May 4, 1994.

2a. I would appreciate if you would advise me of the disposition of the enclosed Notice of Appeal, dated January 20, 1994.

b. It was sent to your office, by certified mail, when the copies sent to the District Court were apparently "hijacked", "waylaid", "shredded" and/or "destroyed". If I do not hear to the contrary, I will assume it received the same truant disposition in Your Court.

c. I would also appreciate a copy of the District Court's Order of November 22, 1993, which is the subject of such appeal, since I never received same, if it exists.

3a. Enclosed is a copy of a motion on a grand jury application, which should be made part of the protest of Judge Torruell's Order.

b. Within the next week, I expect to prepare for a grand jury submission, a publicly distributed document, of non-confidential material, which will set forth the corruption of Chief Judge Breyer, his Court and the District Court of Massachusetts, which I believe should also be made part of this protest.
