



28 U.S.C. §372[c]

1. In manifest violation of Canon(A)(4) of the Code of Judicial Conduct, which was adopted by the Judicial Conference of the United (Report of Judicial Conference of the U.S. [1973] p. 9-11, 52; [1974] p. 17), Chief Judge Gerry and his office engaged themselves in ex parte communications with U.S. District Judge NICHOLAS H. POLITAN and his office, and others, including Assistant U.S. Attorney SUSAN C. CASSELL, without advising me of same, and of the actions taken pursuant thereto.

Thus, the initial obligation of Chief Judge Gerry is to reveal, in full, all of these ex parte conversations.

2. There was and is a conscious, intentional and deliberate attempt by Chief Judge Gerry, Judge Politan, Cassell and Clapp & Eisenberg to conceal that the several motions made by me returnable before Chief Judge Gerry, including my 'former jeopardy' motion, were simply being placed on Judge Gerry's shelf, permitted to lie fallow, or else were transmitted to Judge Politan where they remained unadjudicated.


Thus, the most severe disciplinary action should be taken against Judge Gerry unless these motions are not immediately adjudicated.

3. The aforementioned deplorable state of judicial affairs only came to light by virtue of the trial testimony of LEO. E. STRINE, JR., Esq., former law clerk of Chief Judge Gerry, and thereafter the law clerk of Circuit Judge WALTER K. STAPLETON.

Also revealed by virtue of the Strine testimony was that Chief Judge Gerry permitted Judge Politan to usurp the blind and neutral assignment system in criminal cases by dragooning to himself a non-summary criminal contempt proceeding based upon the alleged violation of an egregious, manifestly unlawful order of Judge Politan.

Chief Judge Gerry, now knows, if he did not know before, that he is aiding and abetting a criminal racketeering adventure, which can only bring the judicial system in disrepute unless corrective action is taken, and there is no indication that corrective action is intended.
