In all, you seek three documents. I will address your requests seriatum.

(1) a copy of the "Report of April 12, 1979 from the Office of Donald E. Humphrey, of the Ninth Judicial District."

This Court's file of the disciplinary proceeding which resulted in your disbarment does not contain such a document.

(2) a copy of the "Report from the Office of Robert H. Strauss, of the Second Judicial District, granting him permission to prosecute me which resulted in the Order of February 23, 1987."

This Court's file of the disciplinary proceeding does not contain a document which fits that description and is labeled "Report." However, it does contain a Notice of Petition and Petition from the Grievance Committee for the Second and Eleventh Judicial Districts, for which Robert H. Straus then served as attorney. That document is 15 pages in length, and would cost \$8.00 (\$1 for the first page and \$.50 for each additional page) to reproduce.


(3) a copy of the affidavit of Donald E. Humphrey dated January 16, 1990, and filed in connection with a disciplinary proceeding against him.
