Sirs

1. As set forth in my complaint of May 3, 2012, whose assertions were *all* un denied & uncontroverted, I doubt whether the Fifth Judicial District ever sanctioned an attorney for misconduct more egregious than that committed by *Frederick J. Scullin, Jr.*, as the U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of New York.

2. Obviously, *Huether-Gigliotti*, because of his position, not desiring to disbar *Frederick J. Scullin, Jr.*, had Sheryl M. Crankshaw, who does not have the authority to make a merit disposition, absurdly concluded that the "complaint fails to describe conduct which is in violation of the Code of Professional Responsibility".

Not having the authority, her disposition is void, and *Huether-Gigliotti* should be professionally sanctioned, in addition to being discharged for their fraudulent behavior.

3. In the interim, all attorneys should be advised, the Court is *estopped* from entertaining disciplinary proceedings that are less serious than that committed by *Frederick J. Scullin, Jr.* (see, e.g., *Middlesex County Bar v. Garden State Bar*, 457 U.S. 423 [1982]; *Association of the Bar of the CNY v. Isserman*, 271 F.2d 784 [2nd Cir.-1959]).

4. The in-office misconduct of *Frederick J. Scullin, Jr.*, as a judge, will follow.
