Sirs:

This professional disciplinary complaint is against *Peter M. Torncello*, Esq., for his in-office misconduct which warrants his disbarment.

Count "A"

After being "*fixed*", Chief Attorney *Peter M. Torncello* made the false & contrived statement that the *undenied & uncontroverted* allegations in the Complaint of May 25, 2012 (Exhibit "A") "*fails to state a complaint of professional misconduct*".

The aforementioned, made under oath, would be manifestly perjurious!

Count "B"

A Disciplinary Complaint was executed against [former] NY State Attorney General *Robert Abrams* & [former] Assistant NY State Attorney General *Alan S. Kaufman* on May 10, 2012, whose allegations were all *undenied & uncontroverted*.

After being "*fixed*", Chief Attorney *Peter M. Torncello* failed & refuses to process this Complaint.

Count "C"

A Disciplinary Complaint, dated May 3, 2012, was lodged against *Frederick J. Scullin & Paul D. Silver*.

On May 8, 2012, without notice or due process, Chief Attorney *Peter M. Torncello* transferred the matter to Fifth Judicial District who disposed of the matter with respect to *Frederick J. Scullin* not *Paul D. Silver*.

Assuming, *arguendo*, after "due process", there was reason for transferring the proceedings against *Frederick J. Scullin*, there was no legal reason to transfer the matter concerning *Paul D. Silver*.

The "*fixed*" Chief Attorney *Peter M. Torncello* is not processing the Complaint against *Paul D. Silver*!
