Dear Mr. Sassower:

At a meeting held on March 9, 1994, the Grievance Committee considered all the facts pertaining to the complaint which you had filed against the Chief Counsel for the Grievance Committee for the Tenth Judicial District.

It was noted that the order and decision of February 23, 1987 of the Appellate Division, Second Judicial Department, which directed your disbarment, cited your willful and deliberate defiance of numerous orders of various courts, frivolous and vexatious litigation against judges, referees, attorneys, public officials and other parties, and failure to cooperate with the grievance committee in its investigation of allegations of your misconduct. All seven (7) charges of your misconduct were sustained by evidence stated to be "overwhelming", including an allegation that you had made a deliberately false misrepresentation.

Accordingly, it was the unanimous determination of the Grievance Committee for the Tenth Judicial District that there was no merit to your allegations and the complaint was dismissed and the matter is now closed.
