criminal enterprise whose activities include the 'diversion' of judicial trust assets to and/or on behalf of members of the judiciary, compelling her 'disbarment'.

. Since I anticipate that no one will show, or even claim, that *Aprilanne Agostino*, Esq. had 'jurisdiction' to dispose of my disciplinary complaints, my complaint of May 29, 2012 should be considered as active & still pending appropriate & lawful disposition which, I request, the Grievance Committee confirm by return mail."

Count "B":

Although I never received the "phantom" request letter, nor any claim by anyone that Aprilanne Agostino, Esq. had 'jurisdiction' to dispose of my disciplinary complaints, the "fixed" Diana Maxfield Kearse, Esq., as far as I am aware has refused to process my complaint of May 29, 2012.
