Honorable Sir:

1. Thus far, although overdue, no opposition has been received with respect to the above motion which seeks, inter alia, to compel the Attorney General:

"to give obedience to the statutory mandate (Bus. Corp. Law §1216), and move to compel LEE FELTMAN, Esq., the receiver for PUCCHINI CLOTHES, LTD. and Administrator XAVIER C. RICCOBONO [to] file an accounting".

2a. PUCCHINI CLOTHES, LTD. ["Puccini"], as Your Honor knows, was involuntarily dissolved on June 4, 1980, with its assets and affairs becoming custodia legis.

b. Yesterday, 6 years, 7 months, and 3 days after Puccini Clothes, Ltd., was involuntarily dissolved, there still was no accounting filed, according to the docket books maintained in the County Clerk's Office.

c. It was also 1 year and 1 day after the effective date of the Your Honor's Uniform Rules, which provides that a receiver must file with the court "an accounting at least once each year" (202.52[e]).

3a. As the ultimate incarnate trustee of Puccini's judicial trust assets, it would seem that Your Honor would very emphatically support my position that there be an accounting from June 4, 1980.

b. As Chief Administrator, it would seem that Your Honor would be interested in having his own rules enforced.

c. Since Your Honor awaits confirmation by the Senate, it also seems that Your Honor would be interested in assuring that body that the Attorney General is giving obedience to statutory mandate.

4a. Mr. Chief Administrator, you have and had actual knowledge that Puccini's judicial trust assets were made the subject of massive larceny and corruption by the firms of Kreindler & Relkin, P.C. and Feltman, Karesh, Major & Farbman, Esqs. These law firms, and some of their stable of corrupt judges, are "criminals" in every sense of the word!

b. The time has come, Mr. Chief Administrator, to set forth your position, in crystal clear terms!

c. Your answer, by words and action, Mr. Chief Administrator, will be reported to the media and the Senate.
