Re: "Feinberg's Corrupt Judicial Empire".

Honorable Sir:

1a. On June 3, 1939, a jury returned a verdict of "guilty" against Chief Judge Martin T. Manton for "selling justice".

b. A more egregious situation presently exists, involving Chief Judge Wilfred Feinberg, members of his Court, and the courts within his jurisdictional bailiwick.

2a. In Your Honor's administrative capacity, I am putting Your Honor and the Circuit Justice, Hon. Thurgood Marshall, on formal notice of that fact, and if Your Honor, or Your Honor's designee, desire details and documentation, the same will be promptly forwarded.

b. I suggest that if Your Honor would request of Chief Judge Feinberg for a complete report concerning the judicial trust assets of Puccini Clothes, Ltd. -- "the judicial fortune cookie" -- and events related thereto, Your Honor would recognize the necessity for immediate remedial administrative action.

3. The teaching of Your Honor's court is that the public is entitled to know how justice is administered, and I intend to fulfill such obligation, without fig leaves, by an extensive distribution to the media and public interests groups.
