Honorable Sir:

I received this evening Your Honor's letter of March 10, 1989, and hasten to respond.

I requested from the United States Marshal that he favor me with a copy of the purported Arrest Warrant, but he has failed to honor my reasonable request.

Nevertheless, I have obtained a rough idea of the form and contents of same from other sources, and have concluded it is a manifest nullity, and may be ignored with impunity (see Fed. Rules for the Southern and Eastern Dist. of New York §43).

I further assert, that with its patent invalidity, any enforcement of same by the United States Marshal, would trigger potential liability, and suggest that he seek independent legal advise with respect to same.

Enclosed is a copy of my petition of March 17, 1989 to the Circuit Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit, which sets forth some of my legal reasons for my above conclusion.
