I shall continue, in the future, as in past years, to periodically make similar demands on Mr. Samuel H. Younger of your office, in order to determine if the mandated filings have been made, until such time as they have been made or until the unlawfully disbursed monies have been recovered.

The fact that I have been repeatedly incarcerated, without benefit of a trial, and have been otherwise been subjected to in terrorem edicts, by those members of the judiciary who should have filed their Judiciary Law §35-a statements, will not deter me.

In view of your aforementioned letter, the pertinent question which now compels an immediate and unambiguous response, is: What are the intentions of the Office of Court Administration to compel such filings and/or the return of unwarranted disbursements from the judicial trust assets of Puccini?

That response from your office, vel non, I shall also distribute to the media.
