Dear Congresswomen Lowey,

I intend to be very active, in a public way, in the forthcoming election, and expect a prompt, candid and crystal clear response of your intentions, vel non, with respect to the privately motivated, criminal racketeering, activities of Chief U.S. District Court Judge Charles L. Brieant, at federal cost and expense.

In addition to my "Open Letter" of even date, I enclose my letter of July 1, 1992, addressed to the Foreperson of the Grand Jury which, as of this date, has not been forwarded to the person or body intended.

Although Chief Judge Brieant is able to dragoon the services of the various U.S. attorneys to advance his criminal activities, these U.S. attorneys are not sufficiently brazen to execute "scope" certificates with the false assertion contained therein that Brieant's activities are "within the scope of his office".

By statutory mandate, "scope" certifications are absolutely required in order to obtain federal representation at federal cost and expense (28 U.S.C. §2679[d]).

In short, by obtaining federal services, at federal cost and expense, Chief Judge Brieant is defrauding the federal government and American taxpayer, and your silence and failure to act can only be construed as an implied ratification of such unlawful expenditure of federal funds (cf. 18 U.S.C. §4).
