Honorable Sir:


By virtue of Article XIII §13(b) of the Constitution of the State of New York, I request that proceedings be instituted for the removal from office of New York County District Attorney Robert M. Morgenthau.

Since essential evidence is negative in nature, I request that Your Honor execute and caused to be mailed the enclosed Freedom of Information requests.

Such response, should prove that notwithstanding Business Corporation Law §1216(a), §1217, Judiciary Law §35-a, and related statutes, millions of dollars have been unlawfully diverted from, inter alia, the sovereign to private pockets, all of which is known by Mr. Morgenthau.

Although a number of Assistant Attorney Generals are involved in such criminal activities, I suggest that the one most knowledgeable on the subject is Senior Assistant Attorney General David S. Cook.
