Dear Sirs:

You are the statutory fiduciary for all involuntarily dissolved corporations with extensive discretionary powers, to be exercised for the "advantage of the shareholders, creditors or other persons interested in the assets of any corporation for which a receiver has been appointed" (NY Bus. Corp. Law \$1214), and some mandatory, non-discretionary, "duties", including to compel a final accounting if not rendered after the expiration of 18 months, (NY Bus. Corp. Law \$1216).

Your recent responses to Freedom of Information Law demands reveals, inter alia, that although more than 180 months have expired, no accounting has been filed, no application has been made to file such accounting, and no effort has been made "to recapture its judicial trust assets, which were made the subject of larceny, engineered by Kreindler & Relkin, P.C. and Citibank, N.A."

Please advise the aforementioned U.S. Senate committees as to your intentions regarding, and your failure to take immediate remedial action, will be construed by the writer as a desire to comply with the desires of, inter alia, Senator D'Amato and Citibank.

If you mail me a copy of your response, I will forward copies to all those to which this complaint is being mailed.
