Honorable. Sir:

- 1. So that Your Honor may make a fully informed decision, I request that you examine the "Pay to Play" operations of the Office of NY State Attorney General, as demonstrated by *Puccini Clothes*, *Ltd.*, where official books have been "cooked" to conceal the *unconstitutional* expenditures made of New York State funds (*NY Freedom of Information Law* #03-540]).
- 2. In my *undenied* and *uncontroverted* July 28, 2008, 31 *U.S.C.* §1351 Demand, I alleged: Neither has NYSAG *Andrew M. Cuomo* advised the NY State fiscal authorities of the *unconstitutional* expenditures made, nor has he attempted to seek reimbursement in favor of the *State of New York*.

A Writ of Mandamus <u>must</u> be issued to compel NYSAG Andrew M. Cuomo to comply with his other obligations described herein, such as to seek reimbursement in favor of the State of New York.

Since in almost six (6) months, the Attorney General has not attempted to remedied the matter, procedures have been instituted in the Federal Court.

Early next week, and possibly earlier, I will move for a grand jury presentation for the failure of NY State Attorney General *Andrew M. Cuomo* to compel the mandatory "accounting and distribution" (NY Bus. Corp. Law §1216), which has penal consequences(NY Penal Law§195).
