Re: Puccini Clothes, Ltd.

Honorable Sir:

1. AS you know, the above was involuntarily dissolved on June 4, 1980, about five and one-half years ago, and since that time no accounting, final nor intermediate, has ever been rendered on its behalf, although there is uncontroverted documented evidence of massive larceny of judicially entrusted assets.

2. The matter is being prepared for criminal inquiry (federal and state), and demand is hereby made that all financial books and records of the above, as of June 4, 1980 to date, be immediately deposited in your office by December 2, 1985, for inspection by interest parties, including the media.

3. In great part the reason for the failure to account, or to have an full inspection of Puccini's books and records, despite the evidence of massive larceny, is the result of judicial and official misconduct and corruption, including the "commandeering" of Puccini's statutory watchdog, Senior Assistant Attorney General David S. Cook, Esq., by the court administration to simultaneously represent interests adverse to Puccini.

4. Any financial records not produced, must be satisfactorily accounted for.



I wish to remind you that Puccini's assets and affairs were custodia legis, wherein the judiciary and/or judicial administration were and are its trustee, with fiduciary duties, and I am sure were this not the case, you would not take such apathetic attitude, bordering on aiding and abetting, if it was your personal monies that were the subject of such larceny.

6a. I would appreciate personal confirmation of this communication, and when I say immediate, I mean immediate, since a timetable has been drawn with some media representatives.

b. I can assure you, as you probably already know, I have sufficient evidence to support the conclusion that it is about the most extensive and scandalous case of judicial neglect and corruption.
