A writ of habeas corpus having been duly issued on behalf of the State of New York on the relation of GEORGE SASSOWER to the respondent, SHERIFF OF SUFFOLK COUNTY, commanding him to certify fully the day and cause of detention of GEORGE SASSOWER, before a Special Term, Part I, of the Supreme Court of the State of New York, held in and for the County of Suffolk, at the Courthouse thereof, on the 27th day of June, 1977, for the purpose of inquiry into the cause of his detention;

and the matter having come on to be heard and a hearing regarding the cause of detention of said GEORGE SASSOWER by said SHERIFF OF SUFFOLK COUNTY, having been had on the 13th, 20th and 21st days of July, 1977, and after notice of the time and place of said hearing to all persons required by law be furnished with said notice and on reading and filing the said writ of habeas corpus, dated the 23rd day of June, 1977, and the petition of GEORGE SASSOWER, dated the 23rd day of June, 1977, upon which the said writ was issued, and after hearing GEORGE SASSOWER, ESQ., Pro Se in support of said writ and Michael P. Bazell, Assistant County Attorney of Suffolk County and Leonard J. Pugatch, Deputy Assistant Attorney General of the State of New York, in opposition thereto, and due deliberation having been had thereon, and on reading and filing the opinion of the Court dated July 28, 1977,

NOW, on motion of GEORGE SASSOWER, ESQ., the attorney for the petitioner pro se, it is

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the said writ be and the same is hereby sustained, and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the petitioner GEORGE SASSOWER, be and he hereby is discharged forthwith from the custody of the SHERIFF OF SUFFOLK COUNTY and from further detention under and by virtue of the Contempt Order and Warrant of Commitment made by the Surrogate's Court of Suffolk County, and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that an adjudication of contempt made under the Contempt Order made by the Surrogate's Court of Suffolk County on the 22nd day of June, 1977, is hereby annulled without prejudice to such further contempt proceedings as the Surrogate's Court of Suffolk County may be advised to bring, and it is further

ORDERED that the SHERIFF OF SUFFOLK COUNTY and/or TREASURER OF THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK pay unto GEORGE SASSOWER, the sum of \$300 ~~plus accrued interest~~, less any statutory fees which was the cash bail deposited by GEORGE SASSOWER, with respect to the aforementioned writ of habeas corpus, and it is further

ORDERED that the SHERIFF OF SUFFOLK COUNTY return to GEORGE SASSOWER, any and all records and copies of his fingerprints and photographs in his possession as a result of the incarceration of GEORGE SASSOWER on the 23rd day of June, 1977, and it is further
