ORDERED that the SHERIFF OF SUFFOLK COUNTY return to GEORGE SASSOWER, any and all records and copies of his fing-prints and photographs in his possession as a result of the incarceration of GEORGE SASSOWER on the 23rd day of June, 1977, and it is further
