ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED, that THE APPELLATE DIVISION OF THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, FIRST JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT submit for approval rules of procedure governing disciplinary proceedings within thirty (30) days from service of a copy of this Judgment with Notice of Entry, and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED, that THE APPELLATE DIVISION OF THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK, FIRST JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT is hereby directed to immediately disassociate itself from all legislative and executive functions which conflict with its judicial function, and it is further
