ADJUDGED that the amended complaint in this action be, and the same hereby is, dismissed, with prejudicu, and with costs, and it is further

ADJUDGED that defendants Anthony Mastroianni, John P. Finnerty, Alan Croce and Anthony Grzymalski, all Suffolk County officials having their office c/o the County Attorney of Suffolk County, H. Lee Dennison Building, Veterans Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, New York, recover jointly and severally, costs in the amount of \$.50.000 plus further
