MISHLER, District Judge

In its memorandum of decision and order dated November 29, 1984 the court awarded attorney's fees to defendants in the above-captioned actions. On January 28, 1986 we determined that defendants Anthony Mastroianni, John P. Finnerty, Alan Croce, Anthony Grzymalski and the County of Suffolk (the County defendants) were entitled to an award of fees in the amount of \$5,435. We now determine that the remaining defendants Ernest L. Signorelli, Harry Seidel and Leonard

J. Puglatch (the State defendants) are entitled to the sum of \$2,661.25 as reasonable attorney's fees for services necessary for them to defend against the frivolous, vexatious and harassing claims.

The Clerk is directed to tax attorney's fees in the amount of \$2,661.25 as costs in the judgment entered in the above action, and it is
