Dear Congresswoman Lowey,

I am a native American, a battle starred veteran of World War II, and probably have been deprived of more civil rights than any person, citizen or otherwise, in this congressional district.

The latest constitutional outrage has been my physical exclusion from the United States Courthouse at 101 East Post Road, White Plains, New York, when there is clearly no legitimate basis for same.

This is the third week that such quarantine policy has been in effect, and this past Friday morning when I attempted to visit the federal building I was accompanied by Mr. Jonathan Ferziger of the Albany Office of United Press International (518-462-4113) who can confirm the event and the lack of any articulated reason.

At this point, I simply request that your office obtain an "expressed reason" for my being physically barred from that federal courthouse.
