This affirmation is in support of a motion to:

- (1) estop all federal courts, including this Honorable Court from making any 28 <u>U.S.C.</u> §1915 analysis of affirmant's filings;
- the criminal convictions by U.S. District Judge EUGENE H.
  NICKERSON ["Nickerson"] of affirmant and his client, HYMAN RAFFE
  ["Raffe"], for non-summary criminal contempt, rendered (a)
  without a trial, (b) without the opportunity of a trial and (c)
  without any live testimony in support thereof;
- (3) directing that KREINDLER & RELKIN, P.C. ["K&R"] and its client, CITIBANK, N.A. ["Citibank"] turn over all monies all monies received by them which under the Judge Nickerson Order was made payable "to the ['federal'] court", alternatively directing the U.S. Solicitor General, Hon. Hon.

KENNETH W. STARR to take such action as to accomplish such result;

- the criminal conviction of petitioner by New York State Judge DAVID B. SAXE ["Saxe"], for non-summary criminal contempt, rendered (a) without a trial, (b) without the opportunity of a trial and (c) without any live testimony in support thereof;
- the criminal convictions and sentences of incarceration, in one document, of petitioner, Raffe, and SAM POLUR, Esq. ["Polur"] by New York State Justice ALVIN F. KLEIN ["Klein"] for non-summary criminal contempt, rendered (a) without a trial, (b) without the opportunity of a trial and (c) without any live testimony in support thereof;
- the Reports of Referee DONALD DIAMOND ["Diamond"] rendered (a) without a trial, (b) without the opportunity of a trial and (c) without any live testimony in support thereof, where it was recommended that affirmant that he be incarcerated for sixtythree (63) months and fined \$15,750, that Raffe be incarcerated for seventy-one (71) months and fined \$17,750;
- declaring null and void the payment of millions of dollars by Raffe to K&R, FELTMAN, KARESH, MAJOR & FARBMAN, Esqs. - 3. The aforementioned is stated to be true under penalty of perjury.
