ORDERED, that the third-party defendants Eugene Dann, Robert Sorrentino and Puccini Clothes, Ltd.'s motion for an order disqualifying George Sassower, Esq. as attorney for Hyman Raffe in this proceeding, and all other-proceedings—wherein—George Sassower, Esq. represents—an\_interest—adverse—to—Eugene Dann, Robert\_Sorrentino—and Puccini Clothes, Ltd., is granted, and it is further

ORDERED, that plaintiffs' motion for summary judgment against the defendant Hyman Raffe, the defendant Hyman Raffe's cross-motion for summary judgment and the defendant Hyman Raffe's motion to strike plaintiffs' complaint are held in abeyance, and it is further

ORDERED, that George Sassower, Esq., or any attorney affilitated or in any way associated with him, is disqualified from representing Hyman Raffe in this action, and in all other actions—or matters—wherein—George Sassower, Esq. represents—an interest—adverse—to—the third—party defendants—Eugene—Dann, Robert Sorrentino—and-Puccini—Clothes,—Ltd., and it is further

ORDERED, that a copy of this Order With Notice of Entry shall be served personally upon the defendant Hyman Raffe, and that service of this Order shall constitute notice pursuant to CPLR §321, and it is further

ORDERED, that thirty days after service of a copy of this Order With Notice Of Entry upon defendant Hyman Raffe, any party may re-activate the motions held in abeyance by requesting upon notice to all parties consideration of said motions by the Court.
