 capacity as court-appointed permanent receiver for Puccini
 Clothes, Ltd., arising out of or relating to Puccini Clothes,
 Ltd., its shareholders, officers, directors or employees, or
 its judicial dissolution, or the litigations or proceedings
 arising therefrom, or the receivership, or the representation
 of the receiver by Feltman, Karesh & Major; and
- (b) permanently enjoining and staying prosecution of the actions entitled "Hyman Raffe, individually and on behalf of Puccini Clothes, Ltd. v. Lee Feltman, Feltman, Karesh & Major, et al., "George Sassower v. Donald F. Schneider, Feltman, Karesh & Major, et al." and "Hyman Raffe individually and on behalf of Puccini Clothes, Ltd. v. ORDERED, that pending the hearing and determination of this motion, George Sassower, Esq. and Hyman Raffe, and all those acting in concert or cooperation with either or both of them, are hereby enjoined and restrained from serving or filing in any tribunal or court of this State any further lawsuits or proceedings against the law firm of Feltman, Karesh & Major or any member or employee thereof or anyone affiliated therewith, or against its client, Lee Feltman, Esq. in his capacity as court-appointed permanent receiver for Puccini Clothes, Ltd., arising out of or relating to Puccini Clothes, Ltd., its shareholders, officers, directors or employees, or its judicial dissolution, or the litigations or proceedings arising therefrom, or the receivership, or the representation of the receiver by Feltman, Karesh & Major; and it is further

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of this motion, George Sassower, Esq. and Hyman Raffe and all those acting in concert or cooperation with either or both of them, are hereby enjoined and restrained from serving an amended complaint or interposing any additional claim without leave of court, in the following actions: "Hyman Raffe, individually and on behalf of Puccini Clothes, Ltd. v. Lee Feltman, Feltman, Karesh & Major, et al."; "George Sassower v. Donald F. Schneider, Feltman, Karesh & Major, et al."; and "Hyman Raffe individually and on behalf of Puccini Clothes, Ltd. v. Kreindler & Relkin, P.C, Feltman, Karesh & Major and Arutt, Nachamie, Benjamin, Lipkin & Kirschner, P.C."; and it is
