Dear Mr. Straus:

Pursuant to your request, enclosed is a copy of the order of the Honorable Ira Gammerman, dated January 23, 1985, enjoining George Sassower, Esq. and Mr. Hyman Raffe from instituting further suits against, inter alia, the litigants and their attorneys. I think it is quite clear from the entire order that the order enjoins Mr. Sassower from commencing or affirmatively prosecuting grievances against the attorneys for the various parties in this matter and that it is equally apparent that it is neither the intent nor the effect of the order to prevent Mr. Sassower from responding to a grievance filed against him. It is curious at least to note that Mr. Sassower deems himself bound by a strained reading of Judge Gammerman's order when it comes to responding to grievances filed against him while at the same time Mr. Sassower ignores the clear and unambiguous provisions of the order which enjoined him from, inter alia, filing or serving a lawsuit against Feltman, Karesh & Major.

Accordingly, any claim by Mr. Sassower that he is barred from communicating with you under the terms of Judge Gammerman's order appears to be an attempt by him to mislead with the obvious intent of disrupting and impeding your investigation.

We shall, of course, continue to provide you with any and all materials relevant to your investigation.
