Dear Mr. Straus:

I enclose herewith a copy of a decision by Justice Saxe in which he granted the Receiver's motion to punish George Sassower for a criminal contempt of Court, based on Mr. Sassower's violation of the permanent injunction Order granted by Judge Gammerman. Still pending is the Receiver's entirely separate motion to confirm the Report of Referee Diamond which recommended that Mr. Sassower be punished for 63 separate counts of criminal contempt. I will forward a copy of a criminal contempt Order as soon as it is entered.

I also enclose a copy of the latest lawsuit filed by Mr. Sassower against the Receiver, entitled "Puccini Clothes, Ltd. v. Hon. Francis T. Murphy, presiding Justice, et al." Mr. Sassower's purported representation of Puccini Clothes, Ltd. in this action once again violates the Order of Judge Greenfield which permanently enjoined Mr. Sassower from continuing improperly to represent Puccini.
