Honorable Sir:

- In yesterday's mail, I received a Notice of Appeal from the firm of Feltman, Karesh, Major, & Farbman, Esgs., dated March 19, 1986, appealing from an Order from Referee Donald Diamond, entered on March 17, 1986.
- Annexed to the Notice of Appeal is a copy 2. of such purported (undated) Order of Referee Donald Diamond, which contains the following statement (p. 8):

"According to Mr. Raffe's testimony, he terminated his relationship with Mr. Sassower in a telephone conversation had when Mr. Sassower was confined to the Bronx House of Detention." [emphasis supplied]

- I was not present when such purported testimony was given; was not invited to attend; did not know that it such testimony was given; do not know when such testimony was given; do not have a transcript of same; and as all matters with Referee Donald Diamond, it probably took place in a secret, "non-public sessions" (cf. Judiciary Law §4).
- 4. Nevertheless, the aforementioned testimony by Mr. Raffe, is at complete variance with his testimony, and the testimony of Ira Postel, Esq., before Your Honor.
- I respectfully request that Mr. Straus, as he originally intended, produce Referee Diamond with a copy of such transcript, and also recall Mr. Raffe and Mr. Postel with respect to same.

6a. Inquiry is further made as to whether Mr. Straus and/or Mr. Postel knew of such testimony before Referee Diamond, or the thrust of same, and failed to disclose it during the proceedings before Your Honor?

I again suggest and contend that if Mr. Straus witnesses would come with relevant records, the inconsistent, false, and perjurious testimony by Mr. Straus' witnesses would not be given.
