"Following up my yesterday's voice mail message, at about 11:10 am, to which I received no call back, and my voice mail message today, which I left at about 2:20 pm -- half an hour ago, requesting the Fund for Modern Courts' e-mail address -- none being posted on your website – here's the link to the webpage of CJA's website posting my November 25th letter to Chief Administrative Lawrence Marks -- indicating, as cc's, all the judicial pay raise witnesses who testified before the Commission on Legislative, Judicial & Executive Compensation at its November 4<sup>th</sup> and November 14<sup>th</sup> hearings: <a href="http://www.judgewatch.org/web-pages/searching-nys/force-of-law-commissions/part-e-chapter60-laws-2015/11-25-19-ltr-to-marks-etc.htm">http://www.judgewatch.org/web-pages/searching-nys/force-of-law-commissions/part-e-chapter60-laws-2015/11-25-19-ltr-to-marks-etc.htm</a>. I thereupon called the Fund again (212-541-6741) and advised that my November 25, 2019 letter to Chief Administrative Judge Marks could be easily accessed from CJA's website, <a href="www.judgewatch.org">www.judgewatch.org</a>, via the top panel "Latest News".

I received no subsequent return call from Mr. Hawkins or the Fund for Modern Courts.
