NOTICE of Your Duty to Void the December 10, 2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative & Executive RE: Compensation that Boosted Your Salaries

This is to give you NOTICE of what you should already know: that the December 10, 2018 Report of the Committee on Legislative & Executive Compensation that boosted your salaries is a fraud upon the People of the State of New York - and a larceny of their tax dollars.

To assist you in belatedly discharging your responsibilities to protect the People you were elected to serve, attached is the Center for Judicial Accountability's formal NOTICE to you, transmitting an analysis of the December 10, 2018 Report. Four hard copies, with the exhibits to the analysis, will be sent, priority-mail:

- (1) to the Governor, for himself and the Lieutenant Governor;
- (2) to the Attorney General;
- (3) to the Temporary Senate President, for herself & the other 62 Senate Members; and
- (4) to the Assembly Speaker, for himself & the other 149 Assembly Members.
