YES. I am simultaneously filing this conflict-of-interest/corruption complaint with the First Department Attorney Grievance Committee, with respect to Solicitor General Barbara Underwood and with the Third Department Attorney Grievance Committee with respect to Assistant Solicitors General Victor Paladino and



Frederick Brodie and Assistant Attorneys General Helena Lynch and Christopher Liberati-Conant. I have also filed a related February 11, 2021 conflict-of-interest/corruption complaint against the judges with the Commission on Judicial Conduct, which is enclosed herewith.

Additionally – and criminally – I have filed a June 4, 2020 grand jury/corruption complaint with Albany County District Attorney P. David Soares and, additionally, a November 3, 2020 corruption complaint with the U.S. Attorney for the Northern District of New York Antoinette Bacon.

Action Taken: No response, as yet – except for a July 27, 2020 letter from Albany D.A. Soares, signed by the bureau chief of his so-called “Public Integrity Unit”, Assistant District Attorney Linda Griggs, advising:


“We have received the information you submitted with regard to your corruption complaint pertaining to Legislative and Executive compensation. Due to the nature of that matter, the appropriate entities to investigate the allegations you raise are the New York State Joint Commission on Public Ethics and the Legislative Ethics Commission.”
