What action was taken by the agency?

No response from the first two, to which complaints were filed on February 5, 2025 and February 6, 2025, respectively. The complaints to the other agencies and officers are being filed today.

COURT ACTION TAKEN BY YOU AGAINST THE ATTORNEY:

Have you taken any civil or criminal action against the attorney?

CJA v. Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation, et al., Albany County Supreme Court ([#902654-24](#)), at the New York Court of Appeals on a direct appeal of right ([APL-2024-149](#), [APL-2024-175](#)).

ALLEGATIONS:

This is a conflict-of-interest/corruption complaint against attorney Theresa Egan (#2108074/Third Dept. 1987), one of seven members of the New York State Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation, for her knowing and deliberate violations of, *inter alia*:

- [Public Officers Law §74](#) “Code of Ethics”;
- [Penal Law §175.35](#): “Offering a false instrument for filing in the first degree”;
- [Penal Law §195](#): “Official misconduct”;
- [Penal Law §105.15](#): “Conspiracy in the second degree”;
- [Penal Law §20.00](#): “Criminal liability for conduct of another”;
- [Penal Law Article 496: “PUBLIC TRUST ACT”](#) –
 - [§496.06](#): “Public corruption”;
 - [§496.05](#): “Corrupting the government in the first degree”.

These constitute violations of [New York’s Rules of Professional Conduct](#) and, specifically, Rule 8.4 “Misconduct” and Rule 8.3 “Reporting Professional Misconduct”, over which the Appellate Division Attorney Grievance Committees have jurisdiction.

The facts and evidence substantiating this complaint are furnished by CJA’s February 3, 2025 Opposition Report to the Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation’s misnomered November 14, 2024 “Final Report on Legislative and Executive Compensation”.
