As you know, there is pending litigation concerning allegations which are substantially similar to the material allegations of professional misconduct you have alleged here. In particular, your allegations that Barbara Underwood engaged in litigation fraud and had conflicts of interest will likely be litigated as part of your appeal to the Court of Appeals.

We have found that a judicial determination of such matters is helpful to the Committee. Accordingly, we have determined to defer further investigation at this time.
