LETTER TO THE EDITOR -

Your endorsement of Shelley Mayer as state senator because she "has a stronger stand on the need to clean up the sewer that is the state Capitol" flies in the face of DOCUMENTARY & VIDEO EVIDENCE, establishing her to be a perpetrator and perpetuator of corruption. The EVIDENCE, going back nearly 25 years to when she was counsel to Attorney General G.
