This follows up the message I sent you earlier this morning, *via* your <u>website contact page</u>, before seeing the posted <u>info@judicial.network.com</u> e-mail address that I am now using.

I am director and co-founder of the New York-based national, non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization, Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. (CJA) — and wish to alert you to President Biden's politicization of the DOJ by his 4 U.S. Attorney nominations for New York — presently before the Senate Judiciary Committee, which is COLLUDING with him. By this I mean not just the Democratic majority, but the Republican minority.

On March 23<sup>rd</sup> and April 27<sup>th</sup>, I sent the Biden White House written messages as to the necessity to carefully vet the prospective 4 U.S. Attorney nominees for New York for conflicts of interest, lest they politicize the U.S. Attorney offices by NOT prosecuting for public corruption New York's mostly Democratic highest state officers – the subject of a FULLY-DOCUMENTED complaint that NY's 4 acting U.S. Attorneys are "sitting on". I received NO response, other than automated acknowledgments of receipt.

On <u>July 26<sup>th</sup></u>, the Biden White House announced its first set of 8 U.S. Attorney nominations – among them for New York's western district. Hoping for "leadership" from Republican Senate Judiciary Committee Member Josh Hawley, I reached out to him, including by the above-attached August 4<sup>th</sup> letter, to which I received NO response. Thereafter, in the wake of the <u>August 10<sup>th</sup></u> White House announcement of a second set of 8 U.S. Attorney nominations, 3 of which were for New York's other districts: southern, eastern, and northern, I reached out to other Republican Senate Judiciary Committee minority members – and then to the Senate Judiciary Committee's Democratic majority office, to its Republican minority office and to Democratic minority members. My chain of e-mails reciting what has been happening – culminating in my September 3<sup>rd</sup> e-mail, to which I have received NO response – is below.

In short, the Democratic Senate Judiciary Committee majority office does NOT answer its phones, return voice messages, or respond to requests for info and documents pertaining to President Biden's 4 U.S. Attorney nominees for New York. The Republican Senate Judiciary Committee minority office and members are only marginally better — notwithstanding the HUGE opportunity that my August 4<sup>th</sup> letter furnished them to raise essential questions about Biden White House vetting, to topple — by the answers — New York's mostly-Democratic highest state officers in its three government branches, to demonstrate a modicum of fealty to former President Trump, and to PROVE, resoundingly, and starting with <a href="https://example.com/">The New York Times</a>, that New York has an agenda-driven/"fake news"/election-rigging press—virtually all of it "left-leaning" and "progressive" — which, for years, has been knowingly and deliberately covering up and perpetuating New York's corrupt and unconstitutional state governance.
