This follows up the message I sent you earlier this morning, *via* your [website contact page](#), before seeing the posted info@judicial.network.com e-mail address that I am now using.

I am director and co-founder of the New York-based national, non-partisan, non-profit citizens' organization, Center for Judicial Accountability, Inc. (CJA) – and wish to alert you to **President Biden's politicization of the DOJ by his 4 U.S. Attorney nominations for New York -- presently before the Senate Judiciary Committee, which is COLLUDING with him. By this I mean not just the Democratic majority, but the Republican minority.**

On [March 23rd](#) and [April 27th](#), I sent the Biden White House written messages as to the necessity to carefully vet the prospective 4 U.S. Attorney nominees for New York for conflicts of interest, lest they politicize the U.S. Attorney offices by NOT prosecuting for public corruption New York's mostly Democratic highest state officers – the subject of a FULLY-DOCUMENTED complaint that NY's 4 acting U.S. Attorneys are "sitting on". I received NO response, other than automated acknowledgments of receipt.

On [July 26th](#), the Biden White House announced its first set of 8 U.S. Attorney nominations – among them for New York's western district. Hoping for "leadership" from Republican Senate Judiciary Committee Member Josh Hawley, I reached out to him, including by the above-attached August 4th letter, to which I received NO response. Thereafter, in the wake of the [August 10th](#) White House announcement of a second set of 8 U.S. Attorney nominations, 3 of which were for New York's other districts: southern, eastern, and northern, I reached out to other Republican Senate Judiciary Committee minority members – and then to the Senate Judiciary Committee's Democratic majority office, to its Republican minority office and to Democratic minority members. My chain of e-mails reciting what has been happening – culminating in my September 3rd e-mail, to which I have received NO response – is below.

In short, the Democratic Senate Judiciary Committee majority office does NOT answer its phones, return voice messages, or respond to requests for info and documents pertaining to President Biden's 4 U.S. Attorney nominees for New York. The Republican Senate Judiciary Committee minority office and members are only marginally better – notwithstanding the HUGE opportunity that my August 4th letter furnished them to raise essential questions about Biden White House vetting, to topple – by the answers – New York's mostly-Democratic highest state officers in its three government branches, to demonstrate a modicum of fealty to former President Trump, and to PROVE, resoundingly, and starting with [The New York Times](#), that New York has an agenda-driven/"fake news"/election-rigging press– virtually all of it "left-leaning" and "progressive" – which, for years, has been knowingly and deliberately covering up and perpetuating New York's corrupt and unconstitutional state governance.

The above and below – with substantiating EVIDENTIARY links – are posted on CJA's website, www.judgewidth.org, on a webpage entitled: "President Biden's New U.S. Attorneys for NY -- Will they be non-partisan enforcers of the Rule of Law and Equal Justice when doing so will require them to prosecute NY's mostly Democratic top state officers -- &

Subject: Pres. Biden's 4 US Attorney Nominees for NY -- & the SJC's Sept. 15th oversight hearing of the FBI's "dereliction of duty" in the Larry Nassar case (a piece of a larger whole of FBI nonfeasance, misfeasance, & corruption, requiring oversight)

RE: President Biden's 4 US Attorney nominees for New York: Trini Ross ([WDNY – PN#931](#)); Breon Peace ([EDNY – PN #1036](#)); Damian Williams ([SDNY – PN #1038](#)); and Carla Freedman ([NDNY – PN #1042](#)).

This follows my below August 18th e-mail, with the above-attached August 4th letter to Senator Hawley – to which I received no response from anyone except counsel at the Committee's Republican minority office, Gabrielle Kenny, who called me that same day, August 18th, and, after a 20-minute phone conversation, made a phone appointment for August 20th, when we spoke for an hour, discussing the serious and substantial conflicts of interest about which President Biden's above 4 nominees for U.S. Attorney for NY must be questioned, arising from the [December 19, 2020 "swamp-draining" public corruption complaint](#) that NY's acting U.S. Attorneys are "sitting on". Both conversations were facilitated by the EVIDENCE posted on the Center for Judicial Accountability's website, www.judgewatch.org, accessible from the top panel "Latest News", via the link "[President Biden's New U.S. Attorneys for NY](#) -- Will they be non-partisan enforcers of the Rule of Law and Equal Justice when doing so will require them to prosecute NY's mostly Democratic top state officers -- & expose that their U.S. Attorney predecessors politicized and corrupted their own offices?"

Since then, I have left two further voice messages on the phone line of the Committee's Democratic majority office (202-224-7703) on Friday, August 27th (at 1:16 pm) and on Monday, August 30th (at 2:50 pm), to which I have received NO
