The duty of the Madison County D.A. is to enforce New York's penal laws and obey conflict of interest protocols. That is the subject of the Center for Judicial Accountability's above-attached July 18, 2024 grand jury/public corruption complaint to Madison County D.A. William Gabor, sent to him by the below e-mail. It involves his \$221,100 D.A. salary, statutorily-linked to the Madison county court judge salary, \$101,300 of which is the product of three "false instrument", penal law-violating commission reports that Madison County's six state legislators, Senator Joe Griffo and Assembly Members Brian Maher, Joe Angelino, Brian Miller, Al Stirpe, and Jeff Gallahan, each running for re-election, are knowledgeable of and complicit in.

D.A. Gabor is himself running for re-election unopposed, having procured the Republican and Conservative lines without primary challenge for either line. How is that possible? Likewise, how is it possible that Assemblymen Maher and Gallahan are each running for re-election unopposed, both on Republican and Conservative lines for which neither faced primary challenges. Indeed, how is it that none of Madison County's six re-election-seeking state legislators faced any primary challenges?

I have received no response from D.A. Gabor to the July 18, 2024 grand jury/public corruption complaint, which requested his response by August 1, 2024 to two simple questions:

- (1) whether he would repudiate the \$101,300 salary difference and advise Madison County to secure a judicial declaration voiding the three "false instrument", penal law-violating commission reports?;
- (2) whether he would recuse himself from the July 18, 2024 grand jury/public corruption complaint and secure an independent prosecutor?

As D.A. Gabor will surely be more responsive to inquiries from WRVO, I am cc'ing him.

Please call me so that we can discuss the above two questions and your election reporting and editorializing about Madison County's D.A. race, state legislative races, and judicial races – all involving "false instrument", penal law-violating salaries for these offices.
