New York City's 93 state legislators, most running for re-election, are the subject of the Center for Judicial Accountability's above-attached and here-linked [July 18, 2024 grand jury/public corruption complaint to New York City's five district attorneys](#), prioritizing (at pp. 2-4) the 13 holding powerful leadership positions:

- Assembly Speaker Carl Heastie (Bronx County);
- Senate Deputy Majority Leader Michael Giannaris, Esq. (Queens County);
- Senate Deputy Minority Leader Andrew Lanza, Esq. (Richmond County);
- Senate Judiciary Committee Chair Brad Hoylman-Sigal, Esq. (New York County);
- Assembly Judiciary Committee Ranking Member Michael Tannousis, Esq. (Richmond, Kings Counties);
- Senate Codes Committee Chair Jamaal Bailey, Esq. (Bronx, Westchester Counties);
- Assembly Codes Committee Chair Jeffrey Dinowitz, Esq. (Bronx County);
- Senate Finance Committee Chair Liz Krueger (New York County);
- Assembly Ways & Means Committee Chair Helene Weinstein, Esq. (Kings County);
- Senate Budget & Revenue Committee Chair Andrew Gounardes, Esq. (Kings County);
- Assembly Committee on Investigation, Oversight & Analysis Chair Clyde Vanel, Esq. (Queens County);
- Legislative Commission on Government Administration Assembly Chair Robert Carroll, Esq. (Kings County);
- Assembly Committee on Ethics and Guidance Chair Jo Anne Simon, Esq. (Kings County).

ALL 13 are running for re-election, except for Ways & Means Committee Chair Weinstein, and ALL are within the criminal jurisdiction of the five New York City D.A.s:

- Richmond County D.A. Michael McMahon, who is president of the New York State District Attorneys Association (DAASNY);
- New York D.A. Attorney Alvin Bragg;
- Bronx County D.A. Darcel Clark;
- Kings County D.A. Eric Gonzalez;
- Queens County D.A. Melinda Katz.

Below is my July 18, 2024 e-mail transmitting the grand jury/public corruption complaint to these five New York City D.A.s and to their fellow 57 D.A.s of New York's other 57 counties, requesting their responses, by August 1st, to two simple questions. Only the second question, at page 7 of the complaint, is relevant to the five New York City D.A.s – and that question was for confirmation that, by reason of their conflicts of interest, they would be recusing themselves and securing an independent prosecutor.

Neither the five New York City D.A.s nor the 57 other D.A.s responded – reflective that they cannot do so without conceding the truth of the July 18, 2024 grand jury/public corruption complaint, OBVIOUS from the most cursory inspection of it and the two hyperlinks of its very first paragraph: [CJA's February 23, 2024 grand jury/public corruption complaint to Albany County D.A. David Soares](#) and its enclosed [January 18, 2024 Opposition Report to the December 4, 2023 Report of the Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation](#).

As New York City's five D.A.s will surely be more responsive to you, I am cc'ing them on this e-mail so that they can be fully prepared for your inquiries as to the status of the July 18, 2024 grand jury/public corruption complaint against New York City's 93 state legislators. I am also cc'ing Westchester County D.A. Mimi Rocah as she shares criminal jurisdiction with D.A. Clark over Senator Bailey, whose district is both in Westchester and Bronx Counties – and because she has criminal jurisdiction over Temporary Senate President Andrea Stewart-Cousins, whose district is wholly in Westchester County.

Suffice to highlight that under the title heading "THE EVIDENCE", the February 23, 2024 grand jury/public corruption complaint identifies (at pp. 3-4), my testimony before both Senators Bailey and Stewart-Cousins at the February 8, 2024 local forum on the FY2024-25 state budget, sponsored by Westchester's Senate delegation, and furnishes a hyperlink to [CJA's webpage posting the VIDEO, a transcript, and the EVIDENCE I handed up](#), including, for each of them, a hard copy of the January 18, 2024 Opposition Report and its incorporated (at pp. 2-3) [October 25, 2023 complaint against judges and government-paid lawyers arising from a fraudulent Monroe County Family Court case](#) – the same as I had furnished to the Commission on Legislative, Judicial and Executive Compensation. Their willful and deliberate nonfeasance with respect to ALL this EVIDENCE – and that of their fellow 211 state legislators – which is their *modus operandi* for perpetuating the Legislature's corruption and the corruption of New York's Judiciary that has "protected" them, involving the Commission on Judicial Conduct and the court-controlled Attorney Grievance Committees – has itself directly impacted on the [2024 elections](#), in the Seventh Judicial District, where the complained-against Monroe County Family Court Judge Stacey Romeo and the complained-against Monroe County Attorney John Bringewatt are running to be elected as Supreme Court justices and, in the Eighth Judicial District, where Assemblyman Michael Norris, Esq., a member of the Assembly's Judiciary Committee, Ways and Means Committee, and Rules Committee, and chair of its Minority Conference – to whom I sent four separate e-mails about and attaching the January 18, 2024 Opposition Report, [here](#), and [here](#), and [here](#), and [here](#) – is uncontested to be a Supreme Court justice.

I am available to answer your questions and to assist you in informing New York City voters of the flagrant corruption of constitutional, lawful governance by their incumbent state legislators, who cannot be re-elected because, as established by the July 18, 2024 grand jury/public corruption complaint that their five D.A.s have been "sitting on", they must be indicted and will be convicted.
