I do not deem the below October 15<sup>th</sup> e-mail of Executive Director/CEO Rundlet, which I have just seen, to be an acceptable response to my below October 15<sup>th</sup> complaint to you against her. Indeed, her e-mail, which could have, but does not, cc you or anyone else, does not refer to the complaint, at all, and offers no explanation for her failure and that of her "Leadership Team" and "Management & Staff" to respond to my September 19<sup>th</sup> e-mail to them. What is their explanation?

As for my purported "outreach" for which Ms. Rundlet thanks me, this is her euphemism for my June 16, 2023 complaint against ten INN members for their knowingly false, corruption-abetting, election-rigging journalism, violating INN standards, including 501(c)(3) proscriptions on partisanship, "defrauding citizens and philanthropies into making monetary donations" and "defrauding the IRS". This she transmogrifies into permissible "editorial independence", in keeping with INN standards.

Is this your view of my painstakingly-documented June 16, 2023 complaint – and the further substantiating evidence my September 19, 2024 supplement furnished with respect to [New York Focus](#) and [Investigative Post](#)? Is it your view that INN members, who use their INN membership as a credential, including to tap into funding sources and opportunities that you facilitate, can

brazenly violate INN standards, without the slightest oversight by you. What mechanisms of accountability and fidelity to ethics codes, including as to conflicts of interests, do you purport exist with respect to your INN members.

And, of course, Ms. Rundlet does not respond, at all, to the three requests for assistance presented by the June 16, 2023 complaint:

- “for assistance in securing the investigative, public service journalism that INN’s ten New York members did not do – and were duty-bound to have done;
- “for assistance in establishing an independent nonprofit, nonpartisan newsroom producing investigative journalism into the efficacy of safeguards against judicial misconduct, including judicial selection and judicial discipline processes – no such entity existing;
- “for assistance in bringing CJA’s archive of primary-source, documentary evidence of press performance into scholarship”.

What are your responses to these three requests?

Please immediately forward this e-mail to ALL members of INN’s Board of Directors and relevant members of the “Standards Task Force & Advisory Groups” – and advise as to your answers as soon as possible.

This is a complaint against [INN's Executive Director/CEO Karen Rundlet](#), "[Leadership Team](#)", and "[Management & Staff](#)" for ignoring, *without response*, my below September 19, 2024 e-mail entitled "STATUS? – [June 16, 2023] Complaint vs INN Members for Violations of INN Membership Standards, the Code of Ethics of the Society of Professional Journalists, 501(c)(3) Proscriptions on Partisanship, & for Fraud -- plus 3 Requests for Assistance Based Thereon" and my accompanying two e-mails further substantiating it to which they were *cc'd, to wit*,

- my [September 19, 2024 e-mail to INN member New York Focus](#) entitled "INFORMING THE VOTERS: NY's Most Important D.A. Race, for Albany D.A., Upending NY's 13 Other D.A. Races, 213 State Legislative Races, & Judicial Races", stating:

"If you are not planning to investigate and report the below-recited, fully-documented, major story about the D.A. candidates in the ALL-IMPORTANT Albany County D.A. race, please advise why and IMMEDIATELY forward this e-mail to ALL members of your [Board of Directors](#) so that they can be apprised of the situation and direct you consistent with New York Focus' stated

mission and status as a nonprofit news organization, receiving public and philanthropic contributions and tax-exemptions. ....

Meantime, I am cc'ing INN by way of follow-up and supplement to my June 16, 2023 complaint."

- my [September 20, 2024 e-mail to INN member Investigative Post](#) entitled "RECTIFYING your NON-EXISTENT investigative reporting & NO REPORTING of the D.A., state legislative, and judicial races in the 'Western New York' counties of your coverage", stating:

"If, based on this e-mail, you are not planning to investigate and report on this fully documented, public corruption story impacting on ALL the 2024 races within "Buffalo and Western New York" for D.A.s, state legislative seats, and for judgeships from supreme court down to city court, please advise why and IMMEDIATELY forward this e-mail to ALL members of your [Board of Directors](#) so that they can be apprised of the situation and direct you, consistent with [Investigative Post](#)'s mission and status as a nonprofit news organization, receiving public and philanthropic support and tax exemptions.

In the event you did not previously furnish the Board members with my [June 16, 2023 complaint](#) against the [Investigative Post](#) to the [Institute for Public News \(INN\)](#), as my [transmitting July 17, 2023 e-mail](#) to you had requested, the links are now furnished so that Board members will conveniently have both. I had not record of any response from you or them to the complaint, with its substantiating [four linked 'Case Studies'](#) of the [Investigative Post](#).

Meantime, I am cc'ing INN by way of follow-up and supplement to the June 16, 2023 complaint."

The only response I received to these two substantiating e-mails was a [September 23, 2024 e-mail](#) from [Investigative Post Executive Director Jim Heaney](#), stating, without any indicated cc to INN:

"You seem unhinged. Save yourself the trouble and stop emailing me."

Please ensure this e-mail is forwarded to [INN's Board of Directors Chair Marcia Parker, Vice Chair Kinsey Wilson, all other Board members](#), and all relevant members of [INN's Standards Task Force & Advisory Groups](#) – and advise, as immediately as possible, as to how you will be handling this complaint against Executive Director/CEO Rundlet, the "Leadership Team" and "Management & Staff" for reducing to "window-dressing" INN's membership standards by ignoring my below September 19, 2024 e-mail, my underlying June 16, 2024 complaint against INN members, and my three requests for assistance.

Meantime, I am cc'ing Executive Director/CEO Rundlet, the "Leadership Team" and "Management & Staff" so that they can be heard by way of explanation and rebuttal, if they have any.

Thank you for your below e-mail, responding to mine, also below.

INN is responsible, professionally, civically, and legally, for ensuring compliance by its members with the standards to which it proclaims they adhere. As stated unequivocally on your ["Membership Standards" webpage](#):

“Newsrooms in the INN network uphold standards that represent a promise of editorial excellence, ethical behavior and transparency about their funding and practices...

The public can be assured that INN member news organizations have met...standards..." (underlining added).

After you have reviewed the above-attached complaint, I trust you will agree – and that you will present it to the [INN Standards Task Force](#), of which you are the liaison, and the [Board of Directors](#), so as to develop appropriate procedures for handling it.

As for my own communications with your ten complained-against member organizations – and with an eleventh, described in the complaint – they are unavailing. Your INN members do not respond to me and simply persist in their violative conduct.

Upon e-mailing the complaint to the eleven, which I will begin to do shortly, I will include you as a cc – and all the transmitting e-mails will be posted on the webpage I have created for this complaint on CJA's website, [here](#). That is where I will also post their responses and yours, when received, consistent with the INN standard of "transparencey".

My complaint also presents three requests for assistance based thereon – and all three requests are in furtherance of INN's goal of ensuring "access to trustworthy sources of news", "holding the powerful accountable and strengthening democracy".

I look forward to discussing all of the foregoing with you directly.

Hi Elena --

We do not have such a process and do not get involved in our members' editorial decisions; we are a support organization helping them build sustainability around their reporting.

I'd recommend you address your complaint and detail your concerns directly with the news outlet. If you believe the organization has fallen outside of the IRS guidelines on nonpartisanship, would include why you believe that is a concern in your communications with the news outlet. You're welcome to copy INN in. We would not likely get involved but we are of course interested in journalism standards.
