Per our telephone conversation, the enclosed two 1991 letters to Governor Cuomo are but a sampling of the vigorous efforts our Committee has exerted to bring to governmental attention documentary evidence as to the the true causes for the crisis in our courts--incompetence and political corruption.

In view of the shameful situtation exposed by your excellent reportage, we believe your follow-up to this story should be directed to investigating where the responsibility lies for causing and countenacing continued perversion of our judicial system.

Additionally, there needs to be told the story of how the courts protect unfit judges and retaliate against lawyers who speak out to challenge their misconduct and abuse of office.

As discussed, we have fully-documented files and transcripts to provide you with "chapter and verse" on these subjects.

We look forward to assisting you in your worthy endeavor to raise public awareness of the seriousness of the problem.
