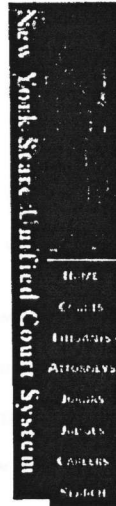

Motions are returnable on any business day chosen by the movant and personal appearance by counsel are not required on the return date unless expressly approved or requested by the court. Orders to show cause are returnable on a date and time set by the court. Personal appearances by counsel and/or the parties are required as specified in the order to show cause.

If no answering papers are filed, it will be assumed that there is no opposition to the requested relief.

Oral argument is required in all motions on notice. To ensure that all papers may be reviewed prior to the oral argument date, oral argument is held two weeks after the return date. It is the return date which governs the time for service and filing of papers pursuant to CPLR 2214, not the oral argument date. Papers received by the Court after the return date will not be considered.

Oral argument in all cases, whether venued in Clinton County or Essex County, is held at the Clinton County Government Center in Plattsburgh, New York.

Calendar call for motions in non-matrimonial cases commences at 9:30 a.m.. Calendar call for motions in matrimonial cases commences at 1:30 p.m.

Motions not requiring notice, such as default applications and most motions in foreclosure cases (except motions for summary judgment in foreclosure cases which require oral argument), may be made returnable on any day and will be heard on the submission of papers only in Chambers.
