Dear Mr. Dawson -

Did you ever do any follow-up to your important December 2011 story "Sheriff O'Flynn Defends Raise, Responds to Critics"? – as to which we exchanged e-mail. Since it was so long ago, I'm enclosing a copy of your story & our e-mail exchange about the pay raise resulting from the raise in judicial compensation recommended by the August 29, 2011 Final Report of the Special Commission on Judicial Compensation.

Much has happened – and the story is not only more explosive now than it was then, but will give you an opportunity, on behalf of the citizens of the Rochester area, to question their state senators & assembly members – who, with our state's highest public officers, are the subject of a corruption complaint to U.S. Attorney Bharara. The corruption complaint is based on their "grand larceny of the public fisc and other corrupt acts" in connection with the pay raises, whose costs, to taxpayers has been approximately \$40 million to date.
