As discussed, enclosed is Justice Wetzel's January 31, 2000 decision in the aboveentitled public interest Article 78 proceeding. Even a cursory review of the file in the proceeding – long in your possession¹ – will convince you that the decision manifests the pattern of fraudulent judicial decisions, identified in CJA's \$3,000 public interest ad, "Restraining 'Liars in the Courtroom' and on the Public Payroll' (NYLJ, 8/27/97), by which courts cover up the Attorney General's unrestrained defense fraud in cases involving judicial self-interest.

Also enclosed is CJA's February 7, 2000 memorandum to the Attorney General and the Commission on Judicial Conduct, putting them on notice of their "ethical and professional duty to take steps to protect the integrity of the judicial process, wilfully subverted by... Justice.... Wetzel".

Please advise, in writing, what the City Bar will do to vindicate the rule of law and public interest in this important case.
