Dear Ms. Meador:

Following up our telephone conversation on Friday, enclosed, for your convenience, is the Second Circuit's Order denying Plaintiff-Appellant Doris L. Sassower's Petition for Rehearing with Suggestion for Rehearing *In Banc*. As you can see, the date in the introductory preface is a full month earlier than the December 17th file stamp date. Is this correct or a typographical error?

As discussed, to correct our own typographical errors, we enclose three new originals (each with three copies) of our above-numbered complaints against the three judges of the appellate panel. The changes are STRICTLY typographical, as, for example, changing "writ for a petition of certiorari" to "petition for a writ of certiorari" (Prefatory Notice), changing "their" to "there" in fn 9 (p. 4), and changing "than" to "then" in the third line from the end of the last paragraph on page 5.
