OPINION

[*1] ORDER

The Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct having filed with the Court a presentment pursuant to *Rule* 2:15-15(a) recommending that **ANTHONY J. SCIUTO**, retired Judge of the Superior Court, be censured for violating *Canons* 1, 2A, 2B, 3C(1) (a), and 3C(1) (c) of the Code of Judicial Conduct and for engaging in conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice that brings the judicial office into disrepute (Rule 2:15-8 (a) (6)) by presiding over two cases in which he had a conflict of interest because of 'his ongoing involvement in financial

dealings with a party and the party's attorney in both cases;

And respondent, through counsel, having waived his right to a hearing before the Supreme Court and having consented to the imposition of the sanction recommended by the Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED [*2] that the presentment of the Advisory Committee on Judicial Conduct is adopted and retired Judge **ANTHONY J. SCIUTO** is hereby censured.
