As illustrative and, in particular, please furnish all publiclyavailable records pertaining to the process by which the four Appellate Divisions each promulgated interim suspension rules in response to the Court of Appeals' decision in *Matter of Padilla and Gray*, 67 N.Y.2d 440 (1986) – 22 NYCRR §§603.4[e], 691.4[1], 806.4[f], 1022.20[e] – and then amended or failed to amend them in response to the Court of Appeals' decision in *Matter of Russakoff*, 79 N.Y. 2d 520 (1992);
- (2) all publicly-available records pertaining to the actions and inactions of the Chief Administrator and the Administrative Board of the Unified Court System with respect to attorney discipline, including with respect to the Appellate Divisions' four sets of attorney disciplinary rules, and, specifically, their aforesaid interim suspension rules.
